## PARTICIPANT INFORMATION:

- **Class time is : Level 1-2** 10a-1p **Level 3-4** 2pm-5pm.
- After confirming there is a spot available for you in the class, go to the schedule page of Tina's website and scroll down to the clinic to register online.
- Bring a chair and lunch if you plan to stay to watch the second class.
- Using PNH equipment is strongly suggested. It is suggested that you purchase your equipment prior to the event. Please support Tina by purchasing your Parelli Equipment through her site. Go to [www.equitina.com](http://www.equitina.com) and click "shop".
- Please bring equipment appropriate to the Level you are playing in. Minimum equipment required will be rope halter, lead (both 12' and 22' are recommended), Carrot stick/string, saddle/pad, Hackamore and/or bridle (optional).
- **Mark or label your equipment so you'll know which one is yours. Colored tape or markers are best.**
- If you are pregnant and wish to participate, please contact us before registering for any classes.

## AUDITOR INFORMATION:

- **No outside auditors for these Study Groups.** However, participants are welcome to audit the other study group going on the day of their class.

## PRICING:

- **PARTICIPATE:** To participate with your horse in **EITHER** Fall or Spring sessions, the fee is **\$385**. You can take **BOTH** the **Fall and Spring** sessions together for 10% off.
- Additional fees associated with the facilities.
  - \* **STABLING;** Limited stabling is available if needed. If you would like to trailer in the evening before or have a stall available during the day of your class, the fee is \$10 each day you use a stall. If you have any questions about the fees, please don't hesitate to ask. Please reserve and pay for stabling in advance so that the facility can make arrangements to have a stall available for your horse. All stabling fees are to be paid to the facility upon arrival. ## FACILITY INFO:

- Parking is available along the roadside in front of the facility. Second Driveway on the right.
- **Please do not allow your horse to eat, chew on or pull on branches of trees.**
- No smoking on premises
- Stallions and dogs are not permitted

## PAYMENT:

- A \$100 deposit will hold your spot in the study group. This deposit is non-refundable unless someone is found to take your spot. You must pay a deposit for each study group you'd like to take (fall or winter)
- The balance due can be split up into payments (or paid in lump sum). Payments can be mailed in or made via PayPal.
- **All participant fees must be paid in full by September 30 for the Fall session and by December 30 for the Spring session.**
